Given the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic and public health emergency, including the continued need to protect grand jurors, court employees, and witnesses from being exposed to the COVID-19 virus, and with the agreement of all of the judges of the United States District Court for the District of Hawaii, this Temporary General Order supersedes the court's March 19, 2020 Order suspending grand juries in the District of Hawaii until May 3, 2020. The court orders as follows:

Unless otherwise ordered by the court, all grand jury proceedings in the District of Hawaii are suspended until June 15, 2020.
